- Base application- Typically reserved for smaller, non-significant, irrigation or dairy shed applications where there would be minimal if any impact to existing water users or the environment
- **Tier 1** Typically an application where there is potential for 3rd party or environmental impact. Public interest may be minimal.
- **Tier 2** Typically an application in an area where there is an increased likelihood of 3rd party or environmental impact. Public interest is likely.
- Tier 3 Typically an application in a high water use area or where an application is likely to attract strong public interest
