Glenmaggie Volume in Storage

Glenmaggie volume to date is **150,285 ML** or **84.6%**, with available space of **27,355 ML**.

Natural Inflows

On 3 August 2020 combined natural inflows into Lake Glenmaggie from the Macalister River at Stringybark Creek and Glenmaggie Creek have increased. Today's combined inflows are **1,803 ML/d**, with average inflows of **3,862 ML/d** over the last 7 days.
